

#### **EXPERIENCE**

The Historical Society of Mooroopna Museum and Gallery:

Take a step back in time and discover the rich history of Mooroopna and District. Their medical collection is the largest in country Victoria, including the very machine that created the first direct blood transfer from donor to patient. You will also discover the invention of the three leg ladder.

The Mooroopna Cenotaph:

This war memorial and Cenotaph commemorates those who served in World War One. The nurses mentioned in the memorial were trained at the original Mooroopna Hospital located across the road.

Jack Findlay Statue:

Check out the statue of Jack Findlay, world champion motor cycle rider, born in Mooroopna. With exceptional skill he overcame the big names and their teams on the Isle of Man.


The Flats Walk:

The Flats is a significant cultural area located on the floodplain between Shepparton and Mooroopna. Interpretative signage is located throughout the walk providing insight and history into the local Indigenous People. To further immerse yourself into this environment, book a guided tour with an Elder via Yorta Yorta Nation

Gemmil Swamp Wildlife Reserve:
Gemmill Swamp is a wildlife reserve that encompasses 170 hectares of Red Gum floodplain forest and Tall Spike Rush wetlands. It is not uncommon to see a breathtaking array of pelicans, ibis, swans, egrets and ducks habitating in and around Gemmill Swamp as it provides a unique and diverse environment.
