EAT

Longleat Wines

Be guided by the winemaker through the full range of Longleat Wines. Pick your favourite drop and enjoy a glass alongside a regional produce platter whilst overlooking the vineyard. Make sure to set your eyes on La Zingara, a 2,000+ piece ceramic mural by local artist Angie Russi that takes an impressive floor to ceiling space indoors. Railway Hotel

Affectionately known as The East, the Railway Hotel is a classic country pub where you can eat like a local. If you time your visit right, The East regularly hosts special live music events, be sure to secure tickets to dance the night away.

Murchison Bakery

Visit the friendly team at Murchison Bakery, where you can pick up everything you need for your picnic basket, or sit indoors with a sweet treat and a cuppa. We recommend the lced Vovo!

ACCOMMODATION

Smith + Willow

A rustic shearing quarters in a tranquil location, relax and unwind just 10 minutes outside Murchison. In the cooler months relax by the open fire, and as the sun sets, take in the natural wildlife with kangaroos frequently visiting in the surrounding landscape.

Be sure to check out the range of B&B's and farm stays also available in the surrounding area.

EXPERIENCE

Murchison Rail Trail

Grab the push or e-bike and hit the rail trail. The 8 kilometres of trail will take you from the Murchison township, to the rail bridge at Channel Inlet Road. On the way you'll find the unique ecosystem of Doctor's Swamp Wetlands, a bird lover and photographers dream, as well as picnic benches that make the ideal location to stop and enjoy your bakery lunch.

Italian Ossario

Be present in your surroundings whilst visiting the Italian Ossario. During WWII, 4,000 Italian, German and Japanese Prisoners of War were detained at Murchison. The Ossario is one of only two foreign war cemeteries in Victoria.

EXPERIENCE

Meteorite Park

Immerse yourself in the history of the 1969 meteorite shower, and explore the space themed Labyrinth tucked away towards the back of the park. Whilst you're there, make sure to look out for part of the Moooving Art herd.

Murchison Heritage Centre Learn the history of the Murchison Meteorite, and see a picture of the meteorite itself. Speak to the dedicated volunteers and take yourself into a time long gone. Whilst there, delve into the exhibits that pay tribute to the traditional owners of the land, along with the oldest European settlement on the lower Goulburn River. Murchison Bridge

Meander over the river on the iconic steel bridge, constructed in 1937 to replace the old timber bridge and pontoons. If the weather is nice, use the river access stairway to get down alongside the Goulburn.

Drop in for a bunch of flowers to brighten your day. Lindsay's Jewels and Gifts Discover something unique at Lindsay's, or pick a souvenir for loved ones. Angie Russi's Ceramics Studio A short 15 minute drive will take you to Rushworth where you will find Angie's Studio. From spotted fowl, vases, bespoke domestic wares, sculptures and custom commissions, speak to the the artist whilst she works in her studio. Inspired by her natural surrounds and love for birds, Angie's pieces can been seen and purchased online and at the Shepparton Art Museum shop.
