MULANA NIN IYOGA WALKING TRAIL AT MOUNT MAJOR

Location: Cashel & Ryan's Road Dookie /Mt Major
Translated this walk very aptly means 'Spirit of Stone'
...Found on the Dookie side of Mt Major, this challenging walk offers lovely views out to the north and west as you move up the slopes to the peak of Mt Major! At the top there are 360 degree views of Dookie and surrounding ranges! Interpretive signs along the trail provide an insight into the area's natural and cultural values.
Distance: 4.6km (return) **Surface:** un-sealed.

DOOKIE RAIL TRAIL LOCATION

Arriving into the township of Dookie, make your way to Dookie's most established landmark, the Gladstone Hotel, located on the main street (Mary St, Dookie). Park in the carpark directly opposite the Gladstone.

ABOUT THE DOOKIE RAIL TRAIL

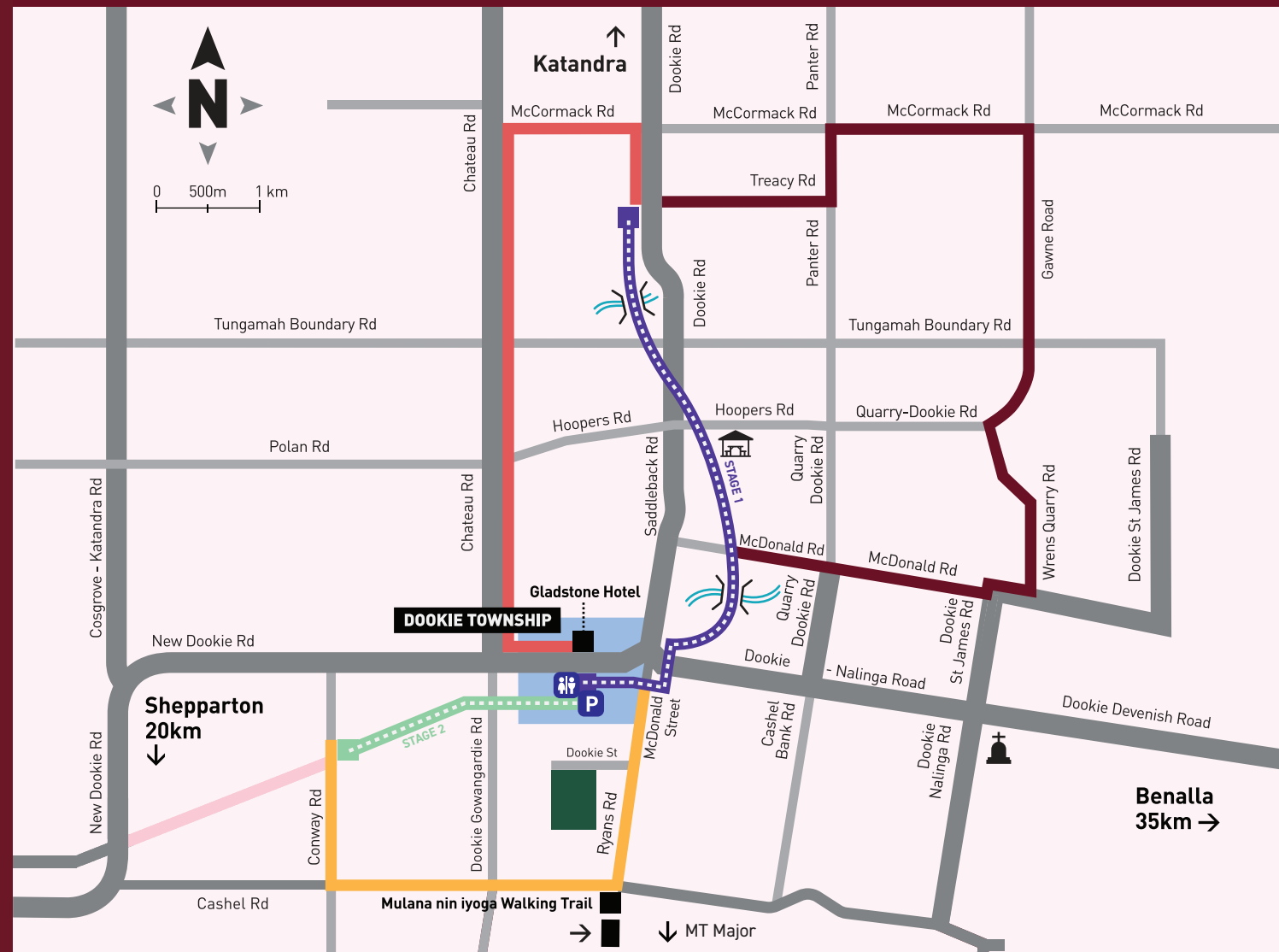
The Dookie Rail Trail is set in the scenic countryside surrounding the village of Dookie and offers two formed trails with very different viewing aspects. Both trail surfaces are a mix of granitic sand and bitumen and depart from the one central location in Dookie, across from the Gladstone Hotel.

Stage 1: Officially launched in November 2011, this 9.6km (return) trail offers the visitor a gentle undulating trail with scenic outlooks of rural agricultural land and rolling hills with each season offering a vast change of scenery. This trail is located to the north of Dookie on the old Katamatite railway line. Seating is available at key viewing points and interpretive signage, along with views of cropping lands, olive and orange groves, vineyards and native birds and wildlife offer visitors a refreshing, quiet escape!

Stage 2: 2020 saw construction of Stage 2 from Dookie to Conway Road, 6.4kms (return). This trail travels west on the old Dookie to Shepparton rail line offering a different perspective of the region with a view that is more open, has low foliage and less undulation enabling a much broader view of this very picturesque valley between Mt Major and Mt Saddleback. Interpretive signage offers a greater understanding of the area and an interesting insight into Dookie's past!

THE FUTURE

The Dookie community is working closely with Greater Shepparton City Council, along with Federal and State Governments, to support plans for the extension of Stage 2 of the Dookie Rail Trail, to Shepparton as part of its future development.. Cycling and walking trails play a vital role within the Goulburn Valley and beyond... we hope to see this exciting and vital project link Dookie to Shepparton within the next 10 years.
