- Take a walk or go for a cycle on our Shared Pathways - The pathways run through areas of natural beauty, including forest and river environments, and are connected in places by on-road access links. Call into the Visitor Centre if you require a map or check the QR code below!
- Mooving Art is a unique ever changing public art display located across Greater Shepparton's riverbanks, gardens, parks, footpaths and public spaces - can you locate all 90 cows?
- Play at KidsTown - open Dawn till Dusk (cafe open 10-2).
- Head indoors to Rebound (9am to 5pm) or Fun Planet (1pm to 9pm).
- Check out Shepparton Street Art including the Aboriginal murals at GV Water, Riverlinks Eastbank, Welsford Street, the mural at Tirana Walk, the Monash underpass and many more!
- Try Geocaching, or go on a Mouse Hunt - collect your mouse hunt guide from the Visitor Centre.
- Go fishing at Victoria Park Lake, Arcadia Fish Hatchery (including a photo opportunity with the Giant Murray Cod), Dunyak Moira Fishing Lagoon Merrigum, the Goulburn River or the Broken River.
- Catch a movie at Village Cinemas.
- Have a game at Star Bowl Oz Tenpin Bowling

## COME EXPLORE...

- Visit Victoria Lake Park, Shepparton, which features picnic and barbeque areas, S-CAPE Skate Park and the All Abilities playground.
- Enjoy some time in Murchison - cycle or walk on the rail trail, take a break at Riverside Gardens, check out Meteorite Park, or pick up some flowers at Avonlea.
- Spend the day in Tatura - check out the old Tatura Court House, Sacred Heart Parish Church, Pte. Robert Mactier Memorial Gardens, Tatura Water Tower Art Murals, and the German War Cemetery. Visit natural attractions including Cussen Park and Lake Bartlett.
- Visit Lower Goulburn National Park.
- Visit the Australian Botanic Gardens.
- Explore the Murals and Silo Art in our region.
- Visit the Kyabram Fauna Park.
- Head north to Strathmerton to visit the unique gardens of Cactus Country (open 10am to 5pm), with lots of special activities over the entire Easter weekend including petting zoo, guided garden tours, egg hunt & more!
